Store data in one location to establish a single source of truth.

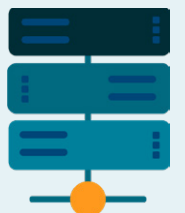

PRO TIP

Specify up front what data is important, so the design and construction team know what to collect along the way.

Be Compliant With Security Requirements



Help safeguard sensitive data, prevent unauthorized access, breaches and data theft.

PRO TIP

Provide enhanced data protection with specific security certifications such as [FedRAMP](#), GSA MiSaaS and SOC 2 Type 2.

Look At A Portfolio From Multiple Perspectives

Provide diverse viewpoints based on program requirements. Keep clients informed with comprehensive reporting for both top-down and bottom-up visibility and quick access to vital details from project teams.

PRO TIP

Categorize projects based on different criteria (type, size, location, etc.) so you can analyze collectively, helping to identify trends and patterns within each group.

Increase Effective Communication Between Project Team Members



Facilitate sharing the right information with stakeholders as needed. Ensure everyone remains on the same page, reducing miscommunication and misunderstandings.

PRO TIP

Clearly define the roles and responsibilities of each team member. Everyone should know their specific tasks and how they contribute to the overall goals.
